Please call 437-3646/437-5606 (St. Ignatius) or 437-4212(Holy Redeemer) to activate a prayer chain request.

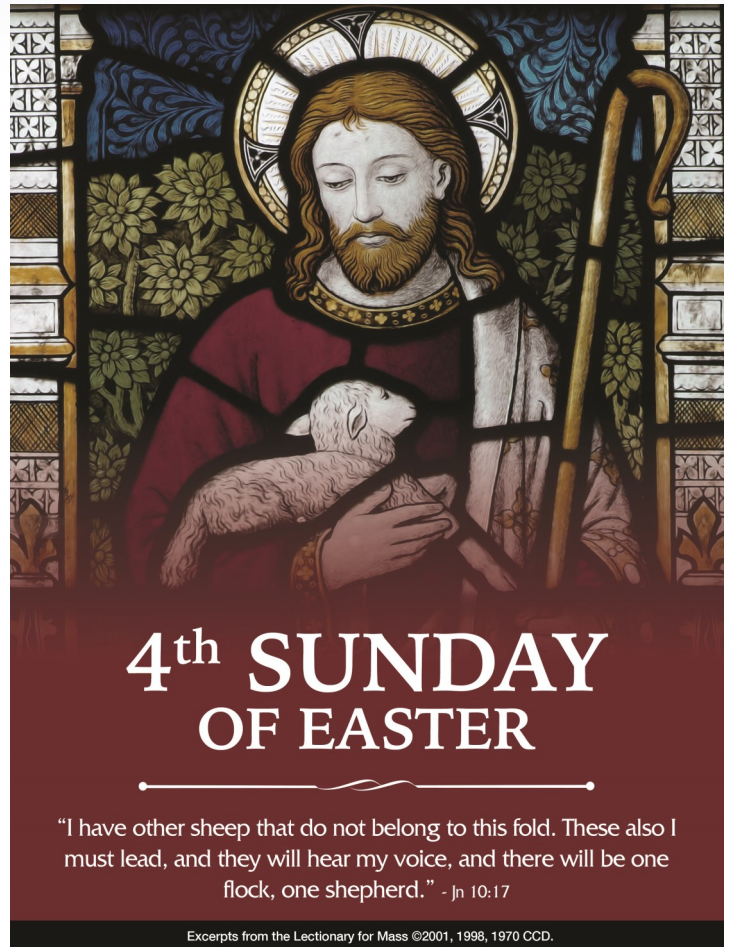
Mass Intentions
